UCAP - Downtown Water Pipeline Replacement Project

Start: Tuesday, March 2, 2010

Twiggs Street between Meridian Avenue and Pierce Street

Tampa, Fla. (March 1, 2010) - The 2 northern lanes on Twiggs Street between Meridian Avenue and Pierce Street are scheduled to be closed beginning Tuesday, March 2, 2010. The closure is for installation of new pipeline which is part of City of Tampa's Downtown Utility Capital Improvement Project (UCAP).

Twiggs Street will be closed for eastbound traffic from Pierce Street to Meridian Avenue. The eastbound traffic on Twiggs Street will be detoured south on Pierce Street to east on Jackson Street and to north on Meridian Avenue.

The 2 southern lanes (current eastbound lanes) on Twiggs Street will be temporary turned into a one-way street westbound from Meridian Avenue to Pierce Street.

This temporary traffic pattern is expected to be in place for approximately 2 months. The City of Tampa recommends that motorists use alternate routes to avoid traffic congestion.
