Greg Slater has over two decades of public service experience, most recently serving as Secretary of the Maryland Department of Transportation. He oversaw 17,000 lane miles of highways, more than 2,500 bridge structures, and tolled facilities, including two tollways, two tunnels, four major bridge structures, a local and commuter bus network, a light rail and metro system, commuter rail, and paratransit services.

At MDOT State Highway Administration, Greg worked his way through the ranks, starting his career in Plats and Survey operations, advancing to leadership positions in the Engineering and Planning/Programming offices, and was named Administrator in 2017. In 2019, he was appointed Secretary of MDOT, where he oversaw the state's programs for roads, transit, aviation, and ports.
