I. **INTRODUCTION**

The Tampa-Hillsborough County Expressway Authority (THEA) is soliciting sealed bids from qualified contractors to provide 100 new Ruggedcom switches and warranty for the Tampa Hillsborough Expressway Authority (THEA) Reversable Expressway System Network for THEA's Headquarters, located at 1104 E. Twiggs St, suite 300, Tampa, FL 33602.

II. **INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS**

- 1. THEA must receive all submittals at the location, date, and time identified in Section VI., Schedule of Events. Any submittal received after the stated time and date shall not be considered. It shall be the sole responsibility of the firm to have its package delivered to THEA however, facsimile or telegraphic submittals will not be accepted. Delay in delivery shall not be the responsibility of THEA. Submittals received after the deadline shall not be considered and may be returned only at the firm's expense.
- 2. Each firm shall examine all documents and shall determine all matters relating to the interpretation of such documents.
- 3. The following exhibits are required by THEA to be completed by the bidder and submitted as part of the Bid **Proposal Package:**

 - C. Drug-Free Workplace
 - D. Bid Proposal Form

- 4. - 5. THEA shall not be liable for any expenses incurred in the preparation of the bid proposal package.
- 6. THEA reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bid proposal packages, to waive irregularities and technicalities, and to request resubmission or to re-advertise for all or any part of the work. THEA shall be the sole judge of the submittals and the resulting negotiated agreement that is in THEA's best interest, and THEA's decision shall be final.
- 7. The successful firm shall be required to execute an agreement, in form and content acceptable to THEA, indemnifying and holding harmless THEA, its officials, officers, employees, and agents from all claims.

8. CONE OF SILENCE

Firms, their agents, or associates shall refrain from contacting or soliciting any THEA staff or members of the Board of Directors directly or indirectly regarding this ITB during the selection process. Failure to comply with this provision may result in the disqualification of the firm. All requests for clarification or additional information should be made in writing via email to: Procurement@tampa-xway.com AT THE DISCRETION OF THEA, ANY VIOLATION OF THE REQUIREMENTS SET FORTH IN THIS SECTION SHALL CONSTITUTE GROUNDS FOR IMMEDIATE REJECTION OF THE BID PROPOSAL PACKAGE AND THE BIDDER SHALL BE DEEMED NON-RESPONSIVE.

III. QUALIFICATIONS:

1. The bidder must include with its bid proposal package all completed required forms as indicated in Section II Instructions to bidders. Failure to submit all completed forms may be cause for rejection at the sole option of THEA.

IV. DOING BUSINESS IN THE STATE OF FLORIDA

All bidders shall be in good standing with and authorized to do business in the State of Florida. Furthermore, it is the responsibility of the bidder to confirm that all of its Subcontractors are also in good standing and authorized to do business in the State of Florida as may be required pursuant to §607.1501, §605.0902, and §605.0905 Florida Statutes.

If a bidder is not required to register pursuant to Florida Statutes, the successful bidder shall be able to submit documentation demonstrating non-applicability of the statute.

THEA shall not execute an agreement if the successful bidder and subcontractors are not registered and in good standing to do business in the State of Florida as required by the referenced Florida Statutes.

V. SELECTION PROCESS

THEA intends to purchase the Product/Services from the responsible and responsive bidder. The selection process for this ITB will consist of the following.

Bid Proposal Packages will be evaluated on whether the bidder is responsible and responsive to this solicitation, with the objective to evaluate those bids and responses and to award a contract for the work to the firm with the **lowest total bid price**.

THEA will determine if the firm's bid is responsive and is a responsible bidder, in its sole and absolute discretion, considering all relevant facts and information. THEA reserves the right at its sole discretion to reject any and all bids if it is determined the Total Lump Sum Price is excessive, best offers are determined to be unreasonable or it is in THEA's best interest to do so.

FINAL SELECTION:

The bidder with the **lowest total lump sum price** will be presented to THEA's Board of Directors for consideration and approval with a recommendation that the bidder be selected per the Schedule of Events below.

THEA requires the bidder selected make an affirmative statement to the effect that their retention shall not result in conflict of interests with respect to THEA.

THEA requires that the bidder make an affirmative statement to the effect that they have not contacted, or attempted to contact, any member of the Board of Directors, or THEA staff, except as expressly permitted in the ITB.

I. SCOPE OF WORK - Managed Field Switch Replacement

1. **DESCRIPTION**

- 1.01 This section provides a general summary or overview of the work to be performed in procuring 100 new Ruggedcom switches for the Tampa Hillsborough Expressway Authority (THEA) Reversable Expressway System Network.
- 1.02 Currently, THEA uses 8-year old Ruggedcom RS900G-HI-D2LC10 that provides secure network access and management for digital data for the Reversable Expressway System Network and has been programmed for replacement in THEA's FY23 capital program budget.

2. SCOPE OF WORK

- 2.01 The general Scope of Work consists of but is not limited to: Providing all equipment and warranty information for switches required.
 - Quote and Purchase 100 Ruggedcom RSG920P switches and estimate shipping time and costs
 - (Refer to specification sheet provided for ALL required switches)
 - 5-years of warranty information for the switches

3. SUBMITTALS

- 3.01 Submit the following:
 - Specifications and cut sheets for the switches
 - Price per switch with quantity of 100 switches and shipping costs
 - MFG Warranty information for the switches
 - Extended Warranty Options for the switches

4. EXECUTION

4.01 Work Sequence

4.01.01	Upon Board Approval, the Vendor will receive a Notice to Proceed with Procurement of this Hardware.
4.0.1.02	Vendor shall keep THEA Project Manager aware of shipping times and tracking of shipment. Vendor shall deliver equipment

as it arrives and add to THEA inventory in proper location as instructed.

4.02 Issue Escalation

In the event issues arise during the execution of the work, the issue escalation and resolution will be processed as detailed herein.

- 4.02.01 All issues shall be directed to the Project Manager assigned to the project. The Vendor shall provide all supporting documentation relative to the issue being escalated, and any documentation not provided in the initial contact with the Project Manager shall not be considered.
- 4.02.02 Questions asked by THEA may be expressed verbally and followed up in writing within one (1) calendar day (excluding weekends and THEA observed holidays). Responses provided by the Vendor may be expressed verbally and followed up in writing within one (1) working day.
- 4.02.03 The Vendor shall provide a similar issue escalation process for their organization with personnel of similar levels of responsibility.

5. MEASUREMENT AND PAYMENT

- 5.01 The Vendor shall submit within 10 calendar days of Notice to Proceed (NTP), the specifications of the switches and the proof of purchase of these switches as well as any tracking information.
- 5.02 50% of the cost of the switches can be invoiced following approval of the items listed in section 5.01. 25% of the cost of the switches can be invoiced upon proof of equipment in route. i.e. tracking information. The remaining will be invoiced and paid upon receipt of the equipment.
- 5.03 THEA PM must sign off that both payment parameters have been met.
- 5.04 THEA is a tax-exempt organization. THEA will provide the 'Consumer's Certificate of Exemption.'
