1. Based on our review of the RFQ, we do not see any major segmental bridge work included in the Project scope. Please confirm whether FDOT prequalification requirements for 23. Major Bridge – Concrete Segmental Construction and 4.2.3 Major Bridge Design – Segmental are required for this Project

**Answer:**

The Proposers shall note that 4.2.3 Major Bridge Design – Segmental is a pre-qualification requirement as the Design-Build Firm is expected to, during the planning phase and design phase, develop bridge attachment designs and details for the ITS equipment, conduit, junction boxes, or similar appurtenances currently proposed to be mounted on existing segmental bridge elements. This pre-qualification requirement will remain as is in the RFQ.

The Authority will revise the RFQ, through a future addendum, to eliminate the 23. Major Bridge – Concrete Segmental Construction from the list of anticipated construction work classes. The Authority will add 27. Minor Bridges to the anticipated construction work classes list, however, in anticipation of the construction work described in paragraph one of this response. Please note, as described in the RFQ: *“The intent of the Phased Design-Build process is to finalize the scope, schedule, and cost of the Project during the Planning Phase and Design Phase. As the Project advances, the Design-Build Firm shall identify, solicit quotes from, and select qualified subcontractors for the Construction Phase... The Design-Build Firm shall be qualified for, or utilize qualified subcontractors for, the following Construction Work Classes:...”*. The intent of this statement is that the Proposer does not need to be prequalified in the 10. Flexible Paving, 11. Grading, 12. Grassing, Seeding and Sodding, 13. Guardrail, and 27. Minor Bridges work classes at the time of ELOR Due Date. This will be clarified in a future Addendum.
